European used car market balances stability and division





Executive Summary

Europe's used car market continues to settle into a new equilibrium. Volumes remain steady, price indices are easing after recent peaks, and market attractiveness is diverging sharply by fuel type and country. September highlights a dynamic of selective normalisation, where some segments regain momentum while others continue to struggle.

Petrol holds firm, diesel divides, while electrics lag behind. Petrol remains the safe haven of Europe's used car market, especially in compact and urban segments. It combines reasonable running costs, abundant supply, and consumer trust, which explains its low MDS.

Diesel, however, paints a two-faced European picture: penalised in Northern and Western markets by restrictive fiscal and environmental policies, yet still highly relevant in Germany, Italy and Poland, where it remains the go-to solution for high-mileage drivers and fleets.

Hybrids (HEV, MHEV) are carving out a middle ground, gradually increasing share thanks to their greener image without charging constraints.

BEVs and PHEVs continue to progress slowly, mainly in pioneering markets (Scandinavia, Benelux), but their attractiveness in used is limited by steep depreciation and consumer concerns over battery durability.

Prices stabilise, but fractures remain across Europe.

Price indices are moving back towards normality after the exceptional rises of 2022-2023.

In France, Germany and the UK, values are stabilising, supported by firm demand for younger vehicles and constrained supply of <4-year-old stock.

In Italy, Spain and Portugal, corrections are sharper as households trade down to older, more affordable cars, pressuring mid-range prices.

In Northern Europe, BEVs are recording the steepest drops, reflecting abundant supply from fleets and strong new-car incentives. The result is a market where pricing is no longer uniform but mirrors national economic and regulatory specificities.

ICE stays strong, electrified models remain fragile.

Europe's used market is now operating at two distinct speeds.

On one side, ICE — petrol and some diesels — maintain fast turnover and robust valuations, sustained by their affordability.

On the other, electrified models, while growing in new registrations, still struggle in used: high MDS and steep depreciation reveal a mismatch between rising supply and hesitant demand. This polarisation highlights the challenge of translating the energy transition into the used market, where household decisions diverge from those of new-car buyers.

Electrified models face the challenge of proving their place.

The coming months will be critical in confirming current trends. Petrol is likely to remain dominant, while diesel's trajectory will depend on political and fiscal choices that vary widely across Europe. The real battleground, however, lies with electrified vehicles: whether the used market can absorb a growing wave of BEVs and PHEVs will hinge as much on consumer confidence in residual values as on targeted policy support.

For market players, the message is clear: ICE vehicles offer short-term clarity, but the medium-term balance will be decided by how successfully electrified vehicles carve out their place.






MDS by Fuel Type - European Market



Sales Market Share by Month and Fuel Type - European Market




Sales Market Share by Month and Age Group - European Market






